Free Money!

Most of us have heard the saying "There's no such thing as a free lunch!" It comes to my mind every time I hear about the Nigerian type scams that keep coming through on emails. The basic premise of this saying is that "if it sounds too good to be true – it probably isn't true"



The ANZ Saver Plus program has been developed specifically for:

- low income households
- assisting with education expenses
- encouraging people to save money

In a nutshell, it works by the customer opening a savings account with ANZ and

depositing \$12.50 per week (or \$25 per fn or \$50 per month) for 10 months (making it ideal to replace the now defunct back-to-school bonus).

Customers are also required to attend 4 free sessions on financial management over the 10 months.

At the end of that time EVERY DOLLAR they have saved (up to a maximum of \$500) is matched by the ANZ bank for genuine educational expenses.



But what if I told you that one of the big four banks in Australia WAS actually giving away \$500 to EVERY eligible person who wants it.

Whilst it definitely sounds too good to be true – it just as definitely IS true.
